PRACTICE FACILITIES

Practice is important to your game. Our practice tee and short game facility will be operated to provide you with a convenient, attractive, and top quality practice and learning environment. We purchase the best practice balls available yearly. The practice balls are cleaned daily at which time damaged balls are discarded.

Range balls await for you on the range at all times. A bagroom attendant will monitor the practice facility to oversee the supply of practice balls and coordinate the transportation of your clubs to and from the practice facility.

Anyone wishing to use the short game practice facility will find balls at the short game area. We ask that when you finish practicing that you repair ball marks and fill your divots with the dirt provided, as a courtesy to other members.

We ask that you stop hitting balls at the closing time so the staff can pick and prepare the range for the following day.

GENERAL RULES & DEFINITIONS

GOLF OPERATION GENERAL RULES

1. Definition of Westbrook Golf Season: shall run from the Memorial Day through Labor Day.
2. Rules: USGA Rules shall govern play on the golf course, along with any rules specific to Westbrook. Yardage finders will be allowed at Westbrook, however, devices measuring wind and or elevation are NOT allowed.
3. Guests: Members must play with their guests and will be held responsible for their conduct. Registration: All guests must check in with the Golf Shop prior to teeing off. The Golf Shop will maintain a record of the guests. See Guest Rules & Definitions for further details.
4. Outings: One Member entertaining eight or more guests are considered outside outings. All outside outings must be approved by the Board and will be required to pay the stated guest and cart fee. Board approved outings and local events scheduled by the Golf Committee will take precedence on the use of the course.
5. Suspensions: The Board of Directors may, at its discretion, suspend anyone who violates these rules and regulations and/or any other rule as listed in the Westbrook Constitution.
6. Tournament Play: You must have an established Westbrook Handicap. Most tournaments require 10 posted rounds for eligibility. Additionally, some Westbrook golf events will require a minimum number of rounds posted in the current golf season. New members may transfer established handicaps from other courses using the USGA method.
7. Fivesomes: Foursomes have priority on the course during the Westbrook Golf Season. Fivesomes are prohibited on weekends and Holidays during the Westbrook Golf Season. The golf staff shall determine if fivesomes are allowed during other times; and all allowed fivesomes must permit faster groups to play through.
8. WGA Tuesday & Thursday Ladies Day: On Tuesday mornings and Thursday evenings, the WGA ladies have the golf course from 8:00 to approximately 11:00 and 5:30 pm to 6:00 pm, respectively. Please respect the ladies group by maintaining at least one hole from you and the last foursome.
9. Thursday Guest Play Restriction (Men's Day): On Thursday's during the Westbrook Golf Season there will be no guest play from 11:30 - 1:30 p.m.

RENTAL CLUBS

On occasion you may have a guest who does not have his/her clubs with them. Please let us know and equipment will be provided at a small charge of \$30. Since it is important to me (and to you) that your guest not be given a collection of oddball clubs, my personal clubs or one of my staff's sets is often used. Rest assured the clubs will not be a source of embarrassment.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TEE TIMES

Starting times are required during the Westbrook Golf Season (Memorial Day — Labor Day). Starting times are also required for anyone entertaining guests. Tee times will be forfeited by any group that is late for their assigned tee time, and may not start until the next available open time at the discretion of the golf shop.

Registration: All players are required to sign in with the Pro Shop prior to teeing off. All players should begin their round from #1 tee unless instructed otherwise by the professional staff. Members shall always check the "Golf Activities Calendar" for conflicting times of play. Any member confused about the status of the golf course shall call the golf shop for exact details.

SUMMER RULES - COURSE CONDITIONS

Westbrook enjoys a reputation for excellent course condition. These conditions as well as the traditional Donald Ross design are what place Westbrook a "cut above" other golf courses. This reputation is because of our Greens Superintendent and the membership being diligent about replacing divots, repairing ball marks and raking bunkers. As a result, summer rules are a way of life here at Westbrook Country Club. Only under extreme conditions are "preferred lies" (winter rules) allowed. The Greens Superintendent shall have sole authority to close the golf course due to unplayable conditions; or to mandate carts staying on the cart paths (even for those with approved medical authorization).

SOFTSPIKES REQUIREMENT

Everyone who plays Westbrook Country Club is required to wear non-metal spikes, Softspikes or spikeless golf shoes. To accommodate guests who do not have them, Softspikes can be installed in the Locker Room.

LIGHTNING PROCEDURE

When a dangerous weather condition exists, one long blast of the siren will be sounded. All players, caddies, and Westbrook personnel must take shelter or leave the golf course and practice facilities until the "all clear signal" is given. The "all clear signal" is three short consecutive blasts of the siren. Players may resume play where they left off prior to the "all clear signal" sounding. Ultimately it is the players' responsibility to decide when conditions are unplayable.

GUEST RULES & DEFINITIONS

GUEST STATUS: To determine the status of a Guest, look first at Family status.

IMMEDIATE FAMILY

As defined by the Westbrook constitution, the term 'immediate family' shall mean the member's spouse and single dependent children and/or dependent stepchildren under the age of twenty-three (23) years old. Immediate family members are not charged a guest fee, they are included under the active members dues. Individual members shall have no immediate family privileges as defined by the Individual membership category.

FAMILY GUESTS (not immediate family)

Definition: Family guests are defined as guests OVER the age of 23 whom are parents, children, brothers, sisters and/or grandchildren.

Policy: Family guests shall NOT have more than ten (10) golf course starts during any one year. They shall be accompanied by a Westbrook Member and pay 1/2 of the stated guest fee.

LOCAL GUESTS

Definition: Local Guests defined as any non-member living in the counties of Richland, Huron, Ashland, Knox, Morrow or Crawford. Guests who are members of the immediate family are exempt from the local guest definition, but must adhere to guest playing times and regulations.

Policy: Local Guests shall NOT have more than five (5) golf course starts during any one year. It is the members' responsibility to ask their guests prior to playing Westbrook, the number of times he or she had played. Participation in the Westbrook Invitational shall constitute an exception to the rule. The Board of Directors may, by rule, determine other exceptions for events of general interest, such as the Ohio Seniors, Richland County Amateur, Interclub Matches, Charitable events and Ohio Golf Association tournaments. Non-Local Guest shall NOT have more than ten (10) golf course starts during any one year.

SOCIAL MEMBERS

Policy: Social members shall play NOT have more than five (5) golf course starts during the Westbrook Golf Season (Memorial Day to Labor Day). They are entitled to full golf privileges on these days and can bring guests, subject to the appropriate guest and cart fee charges. Social members may play golf prior to Memorial Day and after Labor Day providing that they pay the full stated guest fee.

SIGNIFICANT OTHERS RULES

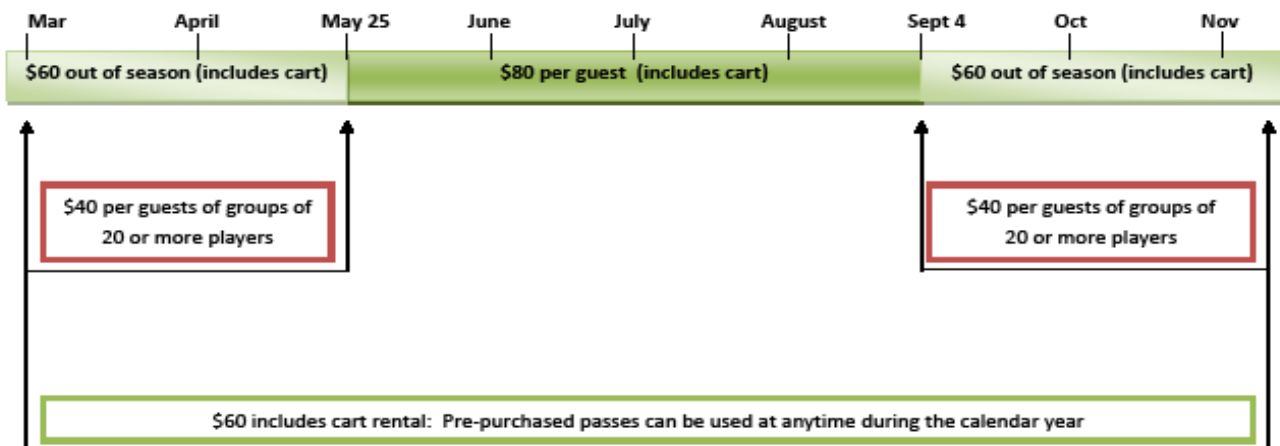
Policy: A significant other must be legally able to get married by the Laws of Ohio and have lived with the dues paying member for at least one (1) year. If these guidelines are met, then your significant other is recognized as a spouse of the dues paying member.

GOLF FEES & DEFINITIONS

GOLF CART & PUSH CART RATES

All active golf membership categories shall have unlimited cart usage. Social members are subject to the applicable play rate.

PRE-PURCHASE GUEST PASSES

Pre-purchase guest passes are available to members at a rate of \$60 (includes cart) until April 30. This is a saving of \$20 per guest. These passes are sold in packages of nine (9).

GOLF FACILITY FEE AVAILABLE TO SOCIAL MEMBERS

Social Members may choose to purchase a Single or Family Golf Facility Fee. This fee covers golf bag storage and club cleaning, unlimited range balls for the use of practice facilities, locker, and an USGA handicap. SINGLE FEE: \$340 FAMILY FEE: \$535

GOLF CART RULES

GOLF CART RULES

1. There shall be no privately owned golf carts on the course.
2. Push/Pull carts are available for member usage, however no private push/pull carts are allowed.
3. Golf carts shall be assigned based on starting time.
4. Members are liable for damage to golf carts.
5. Westbrook Country Club, its directors, Golf Professionals and employees shall not be liable for, and members waive all rights to claims for bodily injury or property damage arising from the operations of golf carts on Club property.
6. Golf carts must follow designated paths and signs on the golf course.
7. Carts must move to paved cart paths near any green or tee. Under no circumstances shall a cart be driven over a green or tee, or between the apron of a green and an adjoining sand bunker under penalty of barring offending members from further use of carts on the golf course. PLEASE MOVE TO PAVED CART PATHS AS YOU APPROACH TEES AND GREENS.
8. The Greens Superintendent shall have sole authority to close the golf course due to unplayable conditions; or to mandate carts staying on the cart paths (even for those with approved medical authorization). In the case of the absence of the Greens Superintendent, then the Golf Professional shall have the authority.
9. Report any and all mechanical defects or damage of the carts to the Golf Shop.
10. A member who violates a cart rule, drives recklessly, discourteously or abuses carts shall be warned by the Club Pro against such behavior. A second violation may result in action by the board to bar the offending member from further use of carts on the golf course.
11. No golf carts shall be driven by children under the age of sixteen (16). Parents are urged to resist your children's appeals to drive a golf cart.

PACE OF PLAY—GOLF ETIQUETTE

PACE OF PLAY

Slow play is frowned upon at Westbrook. Four-hour rounds are expected and you should adjust your playing routine to fit a four-hour round (or less). The professional staff will be happy to assist you in learning how to play faster and enjoy the game at that pace. During club tournaments, all players must follow these pace of play guidelines listed below.

The Rule- Pace of Play Policy

Rule 6-7 states, in part: "The player must play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines that the Committee may establish..," and thereafter prescribes penalties for slow play. In order to prevent any such penalty we suggest that you review carefully the following guidelines.

The Goal: The policy is to ensure a reasonable pace of play is maintained by the entire field, not to force an unreasonable pace of play. Also remember the goal is to have the last group play within the Expected Pace, not just the first groups. The Golf Committee will establish the Expected Pace.

Expected Pace: This shall be stated as the time the Westbrook Country Club Golf Committee expects to adhere to for club tournaments. Front Nine – 2 hours 15 minutes, Back Nine – 2 Hours 20 minutes.

Each tournament is unique and the Committee must take into consideration such factors as specific course conditions, weather conditions, form of play and the number of players in the group.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

Slower players must GIVE AWAY to faster players at all times. The maximum time permitted to complete a round of golf is 4 Hours and 15 minutes, and 4 1/2 Hours for tournament rounds. If play is beyond allotted time, committee may be required to give penalty. All players shall repair all BALL MARKS on greens, rake bunkers, replace all divots, if necessary use sand mixture to fill divots that are not replaceable.

DRESS CODE (GOLF COURSE)

Appropriate dress is required of members and their guests at all times on both the golf course and practice facilities. Dress Code is defined as:

Slacks: No Blue jeans or faded denims

Shorts: Must be at least mid-thigh length. No gym shorts, or bathing suits.

Shirts: Men must have sleeves and a collar, fashion T-shirts are acceptable. Women may wear sleeveless shirts with a collar or golf fashion t-shirts with sleeves are acceptable. Shirts shall be tucked in at all times.

Other: Sweaters and golf fashion sweatshirts should be worn with either a collared shirt or turtleneck. Women are permitted to wear golf fashion warm-ups.

HANDICAP INFORMATION & REVIEW

HANDICAP INFORMATION

While golf is a game of honesty and integrity, any member's handicap may be adjusted by the handicap committee. Members must post five scores before an official handicap is given. The Club uses GOLFNET Computerized Handicap System. The system provides immediate handicap feedback. It is the player's responsibility to enter all of his or her scores. All members playing away from Westbrook should turn their scorecards in the golf shop for entry. All scores between April and October should be recorded including scores from other clubs.

HANDICAP REVIEW

A member's handicap index shall be reviewed should a member win two or more of the Club events listed below during the golf season or successfully defends any of said events. During such review, the scores in the events listed below shall be reviewed in relation to the member's current handicap index. If the committee determines that the member's current handicap index is not representative of the member's potential, the committee shall have the authority to reduce the member's handicap index as set forth in section 8-4b of the USGA Manual.

HANDICAP REDUCTION

If the committee determines that a member's handicap index should be reduced and has at least seven (7) tournament scores, the reduction shall be based on the scores in the tournament listed below. The member's handicap index shall be computed following the provisions of Section 10 of the USGA Manual. If the member does not have at least seven (7) scores the committee shall review the scores that it determines appropriate and establish a handicap index that the committee determines represents the member's potential. This handicap index shall be used for the club events listed for the term of the reduction.

HANDICAP REDUCTION TERM

The member's reduced handicap index shall be for the longer of twelve (12) months or from the time of the player's last win until the conclusion of the event just won. However, the committee shall continue to monitor the member's handicap index during the period of any reduction and if the committee determines that the reduced handicap index is not representative of the member's potential then the committee shall make any necessary adjustments. The member's reduced handicap index shall be used for all listed club events.

MEMBER'S RESPONSIBILITY

During the term of the any Handicap index reduction the member shall continue to post all scores in compliance with the requirements of the USGA Handicap manual.

CLUB TOURNAMENTS

Opening Stag, Closing Stag, Old Pal, President's Cup, Parent Child Championship, Jimmy Schoolfield Classic, Men's Invitational, Club Championships, Men's Member/Member, Fall Classic and Tuesday Night League.

CLUB STORAGE & CLUB CLEANING

Club storage and cleaning services are provided for all Active members throughout the year as apart of your golf membership. Clubs may be stored during the winter months however availability is limited. As a club storage member, you shall receive the following services:

1. Clubs are cleaned after each use.
2. Each club will have your name taped on the shaft. Lost equipment is then easily returned.
3. Each bag will have a Westbrook bag tag with your name and rack number.
4. Club storage personnel or one of the professionals are on duty at all times to transport your clubs to and from the club storage area. If you get the feeling we don't want you lifting or carrying your own golf bag around, you're right. My staff is instructed to do this for you and your guests.

Golf Club Shaft Labels: All members of club storage shall have shaft identification labels placed on their golf clubs. Any member having a club without shaft bands should notify the professional staff immediately. If you have any clubs purchased outside the club, let us know so that a name label can be put on them before placing them in your bag.

Storage arrangements: When new members bring their golf bag to the club storage room, they should register their golf bag with one of the golf professionals. Any member changing their current status for club storage shall contact the professional staff to make the necessary billing arrangements.

Guest Clubs: For security reasons, it is recommended that guests place their golf clubs in their car immediately following play. Guests leaving their clubs on the bag drop after closing will be placed in the Locker rooms. Westbrook will not be responsible for lost or stolen guest clubs.

Club Repair: All club repair is available through the Westbrook Golf Shop. Should you have any need for new grips, shafts, or refurbishing of golf clubs, contact a member of the professional staff. Our turn time is incredibility quick.

Lost & Found Items: All lost and found items should be turned in to the golf shop and placed in our club storage Lost & Found area. Insurance on your equipment is NOT carried either by the club or the golf professional. Your equipment is usually covered under your home owner's policy.

LESSONS & JUNIOR GOLF

LESSON PROGRAMS

Top quality PGA professionals make up the Westbrook teaching staff. There is no doubt you will enjoy Westbrook more if you can play to your potential. Our professional staff can set up a teaching and learning program that is tailored especially for you. Different schools and clinics are available for all levels of players.

Communication is the basis for learning. If you feel you and your instructor do not communicate well, feel free to change professionals. You will not hurt our feelings; your improvement is our main concern.

Lesson pricing and packages are listed on the back of this booklet. If you would like a package tailored towards your golf game, see a professional staff member for assistance.

JUNIOR PROGRAM

Junior golf is an important activity at Westbrook Country Club. Our juniors are the future members of Westbrook or possibly the PGA/LPGA Tour. Our program is active and enthusiastic. The goal is for youngsters to have fun while learning the fundamentals of the golf swing. We also want participants to understand the value of proper etiquette, honesty, effort, reward, and sportsmanship. A separate information booklet specific to the junior golf program is available to the membership.

The proper instruction is vital for juniors; therefore my professional staff will offer junior clinics and private lessons at a discounted rate of \$25 per 1/2 hour. Equipment is also an important part of the equation for the junior golfer. It is our policy to sell all junior golf clubs at a discounted price. Too many times parents provide 'hand-me-downs' which usually do not fit the junior golfer. We want to give the junior golfer every possible advantage to reach their golfing potential.

As for when juniors may play, their hours and days are somewhat restricted. Please check the Junior Golf Booklet for their time restrictions.

While we are interested in making better players of our juniors, we also work very hard at teaching them to be better 'GOLF CITIZENS.' Learning the rules of the game, as well as the rules of the club, honesty, and treating other players with respect are areas they will be counseled in during the season. Regardless of the skill level they attain, they will learn that golf is a game of honor.

LESSON PACKAGES DESCRIPTIONS

Private Individual Lessons are the most effective way to improve your game. Our approach is a simple three-step process: Identify the tendencies, determine the cause, and prescribe the appropriate plan. Each student will leave the learning center with a written outline, which will serve as an individualized game plan for improvement.

Series of Lessons get five (5) lessons for the price of four (4). Lesson series allows the student to cover a variety of areas and can be used as a follow up to a previous lesson plan. Every series will be tailored to the specific needs of the individual providing a teaching and coaching focus.

Playing Lessons enable the Golf Professional to monitor and record your game on the golf course. Our staff will help you manage your game by developing a personal strategy to use more of your strengths and play around your weaknesses.

Corporate Golf: Do you have customers in town for business but can not make it for your tee time? Now you can entertain those customers by using the Westbrook Golf Professionals. Have one of our Professionals entertain your customers for 9 or 18 Holes of golf. See a member of the Professional staff for details.

Group Lessons are perfect if you have a friend or two who are interested in lessons and prefer a group atmosphere. Groups of three (3) to five (5) students will be presented a demonstration on a particular topic and then will be able to practice individually with one-on-one instruction from the golf professional.
